| Introductory Group: Ground Pole Work & 18” Cross Rails The group is for beginners looking to improve pole work or starting to jump and/or are jumping cross rails No more than 5 riders in group | | |
| Beginner Group: 2’3” – 2’6” Riders should expect some oxers and simple combinations. No more than 5 riders in group | | |
| Modified Group: 2’9” – 3’ Riders should expect oxers and combinations. No more than 5 riders in group | | |
| Training Group: 3’3” – 3’6” Riders should be comfortable schooling these heights, able to ride lines, combinations. Group is open to anyone interested in using this as a step up in their learning – please note on your entry. No more than 4 riders in group | | |
| Prelim Plus Group: 3’6” + Riders should be comfortable with jumping 3’6” – 3’9” heights. Video of schooling this height is required to enter. No more than 4 riders in group. | | |
| Open Show Jumper Group: 4’ + This group is for rider specializing or needing to work on show jumping, riders should be showing or schooling these heights. Video of schooling or showing is required to enter. No more than 3 riders in this group. | | |
